

# Atlanta Contemporary Pop-Up presents: Galaxy Painting with Charles Williams!

Create your own galaxy painting by following these simple steps:

## Materials needed:

Charles Williams' UFO printout (or any paper you'd like)  
Paint (Acrylic or Watercolor) in assorted galaxy colors  
White paint  
Paintbrush  
Toothbrush



## Step 1:

Use the galaxy colored paint (black, blue, purple, etc.) to paint around the UFOs making them appear they are flying in outer space! Try overlapping colors, mixing new colors, and moving your paintbrush in large curving motions to create your galaxy sky. Let dry.

## Step 2:

Pour out a very small amount of white paint out onto a paper plate. Run the bristles of a toothbrush (that you no longer use for toothbrushing) through the white paint. Use your thumb to "flick" the paint onto the galaxy sky to create constellations of stars.

## Step 3: Add details and share your work!
